

#### MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into this 11<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2020, by and between the Amherst Exempted Village School District Board of Education ("Board") and the Amherst Teachers Association ("ATA") [collectively "the parties"].

WHEREAS, the ATA and the Board entered into a collective bargaining agreement in 2019, for the period of June 30, 2019 through June 29, 2022; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the current COVID 19 pandemic, student attendance has been restricted through government order; and

WHEREAS, such action has therefore rendered the continuation and/or completion of student extracurricular activities, including athletics, an impossibility; and

WHEREAS, the federal stimulus bill, specifically, (SEC. 18006) states that "a local educational agency, State, institution of higher education, or other entity that receives funds under "Education Stabilization Fund," shall to the greatest extent practicable, continue to pay its employees and contractors during the period of any disruptions or closures related to coronavirus"; and

WHEREAS, the parties are desirous of resolving any and all issues pertaining to the payment of supplemental contracts for student activity advisors and coaches as set forth in Article 1 of the collective bargaining agreement;

It is therefore the agreement of the parties hereto as follows:

- 1. Supplemental contracts awarded for the 2019-2020 contract year will be paid in full as set forth in Article 1, Compensation, of the Negotiated Agreement between the Board and the ATA.
- 2. The parties agree the terms of this MOU are in response to the unique circumstances presented during the current 2019-20 contract year and are not intended to create a precedent or form the basis of a past practice between or among the parties. All other provisions of the CBA not expressly addressed herein shall remain in full force and effect.
- 3. This MOU shall automatically expire on upon final payment of said contract obligations or June 30, 2020, whichever date is later in time.

#### MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum is effective as of the 11th day of May 2020, by and between the Ohio Association of Public-School Employees Local #208 ("OAPSE") and the Amherst Board of Education ("Board").

Whereas, OAPSE and the Board are parties to a collective bargaining agreement in effect for the period of June 29, 2019 thru June 30, 2022, with OAPSE being the exclusive bargaining representative for certain of the District's classified employees; and

Whereas, the Board is interested in establishing and staffing a parent-funded before and after school service on a temporary and/or pilot basis:

It is therefore the agreement of the parties as follows:

- 1. Effective for the 2020-2021 school year, and on a continuing one-year basis, the Board will renew the two (2) temporary positions for the operation of its parent-funded "Comet Kids Club," (Comet Kids Club Aide and Comet Kids Club Site Supervisor). The duties and responsibilities of those positions are set forth in the previously Board approved Job Descriptions.
- 2. The hourly rate for the Comet Kids Club Site Supervisor will be \$16.24. The hourly rate for the Comet Kids Club Site Aide will be \$13.50. The hours for each position will be adjusted based on enrollment throughout the year and at the discretion of the Administration and neither position will be eligible for insurance benefits. Due to the parent funding aspect of these positions, they may be discontinued at any time that funding is not adequate to continue at the discretion of the Board.
- Qualified employees on the recall list may apply for these temporary positions and, if employed, will not waive or lose any rights to be recalled to a regular position in accordance with the negotiated agreement.
- 4. Nothing in this Agreement will not be deemed as precedent setting with respect to the status of any current position or any position(s) that may be established in the future.

A RESOLUTION		

WHEREAS, COVID-19 is a respiratory disease that can result in serious illness or death and can easily spread from person to person between individuals who are in close contact with each other (within about 6 feet) or through the touching of a surface that has the virus on it then touching one's own mouth, nose or eyes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Governor and the 133<sup>rd</sup> General Assembly of the Ohio Legislature have declared a state of emergency with respect to the spread of the novel coronavirus; and,

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Health has ordered that all K-12 schools be closed to students through the end of the school year; and

WHEREAS, the Am. Sub. H.B. 197 was signed by Governor DeWine on March 27, 2020; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to support continued school operations, Am. Sub. H.B. 197, which is in effect during the pendency of the emergency declared by Executive Order 2020-O1D, provides for the suspension of the state educational testing requirements, the suspension of overall letter grade report cards for school districts, modification of the third grade reading guarantee and modification of graduation requirements for 12th-grade students for regular and special education students among other changes; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education wishes to temporarily modify board policy during this health emergency in a way that facilitates promotion from grade-to-grade and does not penalize students who complete assignments through the offered alternative means, and

WHEREAS, the Board also desires to authorize the Superintendent to modify the graduation requirements and make determinations of which 12<sup>th</sup> grade students are "on track" to graduate this year.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Board of Education of the Amherst Exempted Village School District, Lorain County, Ohio as follows:

#### SECTION I School Building Closure

Effective 12:01 a.m. on April 21, 2020 and continuing through the remainder of the 2019-2020 school year, all school district buildings are closed to students. The Board confirms the Superintendent's authority to comply with this Order.

#### Suspending Board Policy Regarding Student Grading System

- A. In order to provide appropriate educational opportunities to students through alternative methods, to allow promotion from grade-to-grade, and so not as to penalize students who determine to complete assignments through the offered alternative means, the Board temporarily suspends current Board Policies on the awarding of grades which shall no longer be in effect upon adoption of this Resolution by a majority of the Board. Such policies may be reinstated through a subsequent action taken by the Board or the determination that the state of emergency is lifted.
- B. The Board authorizes the Superintendent and School Administration to develop and implement a modification for grading policies for each course or grade level within the Amherst Exempted Village School District's instructional program until such time as the Board restores the grading policy. The modified policies shall state that no student in the third grade will be retained based solely on the student's academic performance in reading unless the building principal and the student's reading teacher determine that the student is reading below grade level and is not prepared to be promoted to fourth grade.
- C. The Board hereby suspends any and all Board Policies concerning interscholastic athletic eligibility that are inconsistent with those academic requirements of the Ohio High School Athletic Association for the fourth quarter of the 2019-2020 school year.

#### SECTION III Graduation Requirements

- A. The Superintendent, in consultation with the high school principal, teachers and counselors, is authorized to make any and all decisions about whether a student has successfully completed the high school curriculum or the student's individualized education program and is "on-track" for graduation at the time schools were ordered to be closed. The Board will issue a high school diploma to students who the Superintendent determines have met these requirements.
- B. It is recognized by the Board that the Superintendent is further authorized, in accordance with the provisions set forth in Am. Sub H.B. 197, to revise the School District's graduation requirements and to elect to require only the minimum curriculum requirements in the District for graduation in accordance with division (C) of Ohio Revised Code 3313.603 during this emergency.

#### SECTION IV Effective Date

This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its adoption and shall supersede and replace any prior resolution or act of this Board of Education that may be inconsistent or duplicative with the provisions of this Resolution.

#### SECTION V Compliance with Public Meetings Laws

The Board of Education hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Board of Education, and that all deliberations of this Board of Education and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22, ORC and any temporary modifications to the same enacted through HB 197 (2020).
