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GIRLS BOWLING

The girls bowling team was led by State Qualifier, sophomore, **Makayla Velasquez**. They won the North Shore Bowling Conference Championship and the OHSAA Sectional Championship, which qualified them for the District tournament. Makayla completed their season this past weekend, finishing 43rd overall in the State.

HOCKEY

The hockey team continued their great resumption of the program. In just our 4th year back, from a 3-year hiatus, we won our 3rd straight Southwestern Conference championship and our 3rd straight Baron Cup II Championship. We are the only Southwestern Conference school to accomplish the feat of winning both championships in the same year for 3 straight years.

Hockey also had 3 students who have etched their name in the OHSAA record books. **Joey Kramer** recorded 53 assists this year, meeting the minimum requirement of 50 assists in a season. **Brady Grove**, who is our goalie, along with our defense recorded 11 shutouts, meeting the minimum requirement of 9 shutouts.

Jacob Kramer finishes his career in the OHSAA record books 12 times. This season, he made it 6 of those times. He is in for goals in a season with 58, assists in a season with 56, and points in a season with 114 points.

With that being said, most impressively, Jacob is tops in OHSAA history in assists in a career with 259 and points in a career with 471.

He is second in OHSAA history with 212 goals. He will be representing us at the All-State/All-Star game this coming weekend during the OHSAA State Championships in Columbus at Nationwide Arena, home of the NHL's Columbus Blue Jackets.

BOYS. INDOOR TRACK & FIELD

We have two students who have qualified for the opportunity to complete at the High School Indoor National Championships this coming weekend.

- Caleb Stempkowski has qualified for the National Meet in the high jump.
- Dominic Deshuk has qualified for the National Meet in the 60m hurdles.

BOYS SWIMMING

Like the hockey program, our Boys Swimming & Diving Team continues to dominate the Southwestern Conference. This winter, our Boys Team won their 5th straight SWC Championship. We are the only Boys Team to accomplish this in SWC history. And the championship was never in doubt. We were 8-0 in SWC Dual meets heading into the championships and won the SWC Meet going away!

Their season concluded at the State Meet in Canton in late February where 5 young men represented the Comets. Ethan Belak made it as a diver, finishing 18th overall. Ethan, Chase Arusekvicious, John Belak, Kevin Heyd, and Jacob Rakar made up the two relays who competed at the State Meet. The 200 Medley Relay of Arusekvicious, Belak, Belak, and Heyd finished 21st overall. And all 5 boys contributed to the 200 Freestyle Relay finishing 21st overall. One relay was used in prelims on Friday and a different relay was used in the finals on Saturday.

In addition, I would like to take a moment to congratulate our Girls Basketball Team for making the District Finals and senior wrestler, Clay Carpenter on recording his 100th career win. Clay is also a state alternate at 195 pounds, as he finished 5th at the District Meet in Perrysburg this past weekend.
