## Meeting called to order at: <u>9:09am</u> by President, Darcie Parsons

#### President: Darcie Parsons (ajhpto1@gmail.com)

- Membership and Dues
  - Membership is needed to vote and hold a chair position
- Dances May 12th is 6th grade from 2:30-4:30pm; May13th is 7th/8th grade from 2:30-4:30pm
  - Sherry said that the DJ may be \$300 a day and the photo booth may be \$200 a day, a budget of \$2500 was discussed.
  - Decorations, banners, prizes and gifts, and food will need to be purchased. There are latex allergies so latex balloons are not allowed.
  - The dance will be held in the Gym- NO food or drinks allowed in the Gym
  - All food and drinks will be in the Cafeteria.
  - Having the dance immediately after school allows students to stay without having to return, allows for school staff to stay after work, and students go home during daylight.
  - Tickets will be sold during lunch Wednesday May 11th, Thursday May 12th and Friday May 13th, from 10:15am to 12:45am.
  - School dress code is in effect.
  - Ticket sales help offset costs, The dances are considered a Social, not a Fundraiser.
    Proceeds in the past were split with Student Counsel. This year, the PTO discussed giving all proceeds from dances to the Student Council.
  - Sherry will make the tickets for the dance, and the PTO will provide the paper. Mrs. Neuhoff has raffle tickets, if needed.

    - Heather Pearch made a motion to set a dance budget of \$2500. Sherry Glass Strohsack seconded the motion. Vote all ayes, no nays. <u>Motion passed</u>.
    - Heather Pearch made a motion to give all proceeds to the AJH Student Council Sherry Glass Strohsack seconded the motion. Vote all ayes, no nays. <u>Motion</u> <u>passed.</u>
- Grants Mrs. Mary Scott Williams
  - A grant request of \$400 was submitted for the Agents of Change to get Kindness Cookies, cookies with positive messages and quotes, to pass out to students.
  - Heather Hattan made a motion to approve the \$400 grant request, Sherry Glass Strohsack seconded the motion. Vote all ayes, no nays. <u>Motion passed.</u>
- AJH PTO positions for next year (2022/2023) -
  - PTO board and chair positions are open for next year and nominations will begin. Darcie, Dawn and Elizabeth can stay on
  - Voting will take place at the May PTO meeting.
