## Principal Report: Mrs. Harigan

- Thank you for bookfair. Teachers were thrilled with volunteers. Tax help, etc.
- Mr. Grimmett, Building \& Grounds Admin - Joined us to explain building/grounds update process.
- Outdoor classroom - Update
- School year 21/22-Some important steps were missed in the planning stages and the outdoor classroom/memorial garden project we'd planned for was determined to be too costly. PTO contribution wouldn't be enough to cover what we had planned.
- For future projects, any building/grounds projects, Mr. Grimmett would need to be brought in from the beginning planning stages.
- Mr. Grimmett would like a drawing of some kind. A map of Google Earth with a hand drawn sketch of what we are thinking. Then he can run past the Superintendent, Board of Education to get approval from the Treasurer, etc. Then one approved we can determine cost share between PTO and the District. Once all of that is approved, he can get in touch with a contractor to quote project.
- Change of plans: After lengthy discussion about the origins and intentions for the outdoor classroom/memorial garden project, PTO threw around ideas that would be better suited to our students and building needs.
- Morgan W - project started as memorial benches project; would we be able to scale back to that?
- Benches \$1000ish.
- Treetop (The company the district has used to purchase other benches)
- Like to get JVS involved any way possible.
- Darcie $P$ suggested perhaps putting in a second Gaga Ball pit
- Materials, could we get the turf donated, reach out to JVS to help put it in?
- Need concrete around gaga ball pit - quote was $\$ 3200$
- Perhaps use funds raised from The Harlem Wizards game for Gaga Ball concrete
- Proposal to revise plans from outdoor classroom to:
- Putting in a $2^{\text {nd }}$ Gaga Ball pit and a permanent 9 Square In The Air
- Benches near playground equipment
- Possibly some picnic tables
- Vote to make a $2^{\text {nd }}$ Gaga Ball and colorful benches in memory of those lost. Concrete for Gaga Ball, add permanent 9 square.
- Teri B made a motion to approve, Kimi A seconded. Motion carried.
- Mrs. Harigan will talk to Mr. Grimmett (he'd left by this time) about mapping layout of location and concrete costs. PTO will price out Gaga Ball and 9 square concrete and benches.
- Laminator - Request for PTO to purchase new one, An Altima 55 or 65 . $\$ 2050$ (2 yr warranty) 55 is \$1958 - shipping 250ish.
- Motion to add a line item for Miscellaneous Requests for $\mathbf{\$ 5 0 0 0}$ by Teri B, $\mathbf{2}^{\text {nd }}$ by Morgan W. Motion carries.
- Motion to vote on purchasing laminator by Teri B, $2^{\text {nd }}$ by Morgan W., motion carries.
