

Release of Directory Information

The following is the Amherst Exempted Village School District Board of Education's policy #8330 regarding Directory Information and the release of Directory Information:

DIRECTORY INFORMATION

Each year the Superintendent shall provide public notice to students and their parents of the District's intent to make available, upon request, certain information known as "directory information." The board designates as student "directory information": as student's name; address; telephone number; date and place of birth; major field of study; participation in officially-recognized activities and sports; height and weight; if a member of an athletic team; dates of attendance; date of graduation; or awards received.

Directory information shall not be provided to any organization for profit-making purposes.

Parents and eligible students may refuse to allow the Board to disclose such "directory information" upon written notification to the Board within seven (7) days after receipt of the Superintendent's annual public notice.

If you do not wish to have any directory information released, place an X on the appropriate line.
