



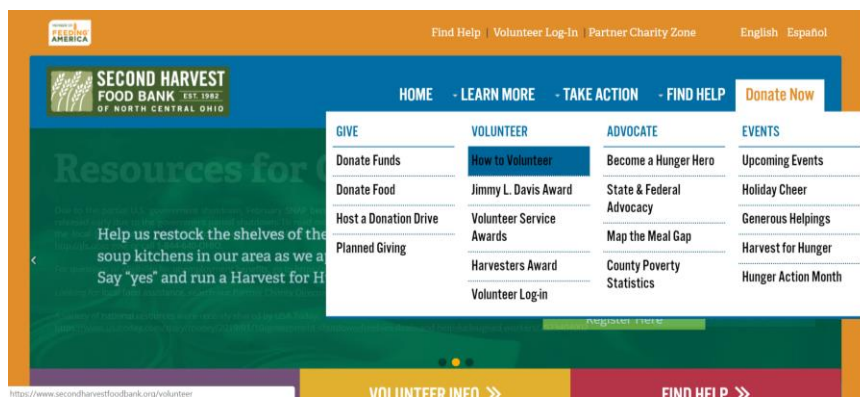
Additional Volunteer Opportunities
