

I Want To Go To JVS, What Do I Do?



1. Students will need to fill out an application in early February of their sophomore year.
2. Students must have completed 2 credits in English, Math, Science and Social Studies. In addition to these requirements you need to have earned a 1/2 credit of PE and Health.
3. JVS representatives will be at Steele in December to meet with all 10th graders. They will provide the students with the opportunity to see two programs of their choice.
4. All students in Lorain County applying to the JVS are ranked on a point system which includes their attendance and grade point average.
5. An open house is usually held in February at the JVS on a Sunday for parents and students to see all of the programs and to meet the instructors.
6. Students are notified of their acceptances in April. You must return your signed acceptance form to your high school counselor in order to attend.
7. Students are required to stay a minimum of 10 school days before they would be allowed to return to Steele High School in their junior year if they change their mind.
